


A home for industries

- Neemrana is an ancient historical town built in 1464 AD, in Alwar district of Rajasthan, India, situated at 122 km from Delhi on the Delhi-Jaipur National Highway-48 in Neemrana Tehsil. Neemrana derived its name from a brave local chieftain Nimola Meo, who when defeated by the Chauhans, pleaded that his name be given to his lost kingdom. It is the site of 14th century Hill-Fort ruled by Chauhans till 1947. The erst-while fort of ruling family now has been converted into heritage hotel which is known as Neemrana Fort Hotel.
- Looking at the locational advantage and tremendous potential for development of industrial activities and supportive services, RIICO has developed 7 industrial areas in and around Neemrana having total land area of 3,270.10 acres. At present, 714 units are under production in these industrial areas with an investment of Rs 15,100 crore (approximately) and also providing direct employment to over 46,000 person. RIICO has also developed India's first dedicated Japanese Industrial Zone setting up exclusively for Japanese entrepreneurs at Neemrana.
- An Export Promotion Industrial Park is also functioning at Neemrana, in order to promote exports.
- Neemrana is most sought industrial destination for National as well as International entrepreneurs especially in the field of automobile, engineering, textile, ceramicbased industries.
- All the general industrial areas under Neemrana zone are falling under the category of saturated area. Industrial plots available consequent upon cancellation /surrender if any are allotted through e-auctions only. Industrial plot in Japanese zone NIC(M) Neemrana are allotted on "first come, first serve basis" for Japanese entrepreneurs.
- RIICO has developed a new industrial area namely Kolilajoga on 201.68 acres of land at a distance of 1.5 km from NIC(M) Neemrana which is situated on back side of Japanese Zone. The rates of premium land of this Industrial area is Rs 4,500 per sqm.
- The allotment of industrial hubs in this area will be by e-auction.
